

## Young Classicist Awards Submission Guidelines

For 2024, submission has been changed due to the interest in the Awards.

Schools can only submit **three** student projects per category per school – Senior, Transition Year, and Junior.

This is due to the sheer numbers of projects submitted in previous years which were not manageable for our volunteers.

Students can create a project relating to the field Classics through whatever medium they wish – *a presentation, a craft, a performance, a poster, or some artwork* etc.

Group Projects will be accepted.

CBAs or class projects can be submitted.

We leave it to the discretion of the school to determine how they will decide these **three** projects – whether as class/group projects, class competitions, or school competitions etc.

All projects submitted will be considered for the special prizes, the Athena Award and the Palma Lingua Antiqua.
